School Programs



Through generous funding from the Manitoba Metis Federation the Louis Riel Institute will offer school programs at Riel House for the 2014 season.

School programs are available for Kindergarten– Grade 12 from May 20-June 24, 2014.

Hands-on activities include:

- Building a Red River frame structure
- Painting beadwork vests
- Learning to play the spoons and to jig
- Finger weaving a mini sash
- Creating your own river lot farm
- Taking part in the ‘Amazing Métis Race’

Half day tours can be booked morning or afternoon between 10am – 5pm.

Full day workshops can be booked for teaching skills such as beadwork, mitten making, sashes and others. Please call if there is something specific you are looking for.
